Free, Safe Disposal of unwanted household chemicals



What is Household Hazardous Waste?

It is any waste produced in the home, which is flammable, toxic, corrosive or reactive. It includes paint products, pesticides and herbicides, hobby chemicals, automotive fluids and cleaning products.

Who Can Participate?

Residents of Genesee, Livingston and Wyoming Counties are eligible to bring materials.

How Can I Participate?

Materials are accepted by appointment at GLOW's annual collection in September. The 2023 collection is TENTATIVELY planned for mid-September in Livingston County. Due to changes in the NYS Electronics Recycling Law it is unclear as to whether an electronics collection will be able to be held. If one or both collections are held appointments will be accepted starting in mid-July and taken until all spots are filled. Contact the GLOW office to be placed on a "notification" list and be notified by mail telling you that appointments are being accepted and listing the date, location and instructions on how to make the appointment. Please note: these lists are NOT carried over from year to year.
