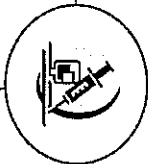

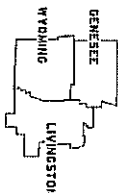


Commercially manufactured sharps containers are available at area pharmacies, such as Eckerd, Rite Aid, Tops, Wal-Mart, and Wegmans.

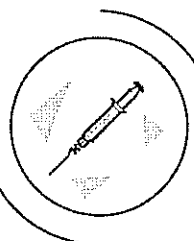

New York State Law

In 1993, New York State amended Chapter 438, Section 1389-dd of the Public Health Law by adding provisions for disposal of sharps, syringes, and lancets by the public. The amendment became effective in 1996 and requires public and private hospitals and nursing homes to accept these items free of charge from residents. The law does not apply to federal facilities or adult homes. These facilities must:

- Establish times for collection
- State where they are accepted

- State how they are accepted (i.e. the type of container they are brought to the facility in)

The intent of this law is to protect the health and well being of the public and those individuals who collect, process and transport trash and recyclables. GLOW has obtained the following information from all facilities in the region that are subject to this law. If you are using sharps, syringes, or lancets, or know someone who is, please take them to one of the facilities listed in this brochure.



Sharps, Syringes, and Lancets should never be placed in Recycling Boxes or in Trash Bags.
